For regular papers, up to 2 extra pages (for a total of 8 pages) will be available with additional charge.
- In order to facilitate a blind review process, the author's name and address MUST NOT appear in the manuscript.
- The manuscript in PDF format *must be submitted via e-mail* to hochin@kit.ac.jp. *Please do NOT upload your manuscript at the ACIT 2016 homepage*, because the submitted papers will be peer-reviewed independently from general sessions in ACIT 2016.
- Submission implies the willingness of at least one of the authors to register and present the paper.
